Recycle

- Aluminum cans/foil/trays
- Steel (tin) cans
- Caps/lids from bottles/Jars
- Plastic Bottles (with caps on)
- Coffee cup lids
- Plastic food containers and clamshells
- Cups/plates (plastic only not Styrofoam)
- Tubs/lids
- Colored, white & mixed paper
- Mail and Envelopes
- Post-it notes
- Cardboard boxes (flattened)
- Cereal boxes
- Folders
- Newspapers and magazines
- Telephone books
- Catalogs/Inserts
- Glass Bottles and jars (with lids)

Landfill

- Foil-backed or plastic-backed paper
- Incandescent light bulbs (no fluorescents or HIDs)
- Juice or soy milk type boxes with foil liner
- Mylar (shiny metal) bags (potato chips, candy bars, balloons, etc)
- Plastic bags, wrappers and film (not labeled "Compostable")
- Plastic items mixed with metal, fabric or rubber
- Plastic labeled "Biodegradable" only
- Rubber bands
- * Six-pack ring holder please cut up
- Sponges
- Styrofoam
- Twist Ties
- Wood small pieces of plywood, pressboard, and painted or stained wood

Not Permitted: Batteries, coat hangers, cooking oil, electronics, hazardous waste or chemicals, liquids, paint, needles/syringes, furniture.

Compost

- Bread/grains/pasta
- Coffee grounds
- Dairy
- Eggshells
- Fruit/vegetables
- Spoiled food
- Meat (including bones)/Seafood
- Flowers/trimmings
- Leaves, etc.
- Coffee filters
- Greasy pizza boxes
- Paper cups and plans
- Paper bags, napkins and towels
- Paper tea bags
- Waxy paper, milk and juice cartons (no foil liner)
- Other: cotton balls, compostable labeled cutlery, waxed cardboard & paper., chopsticks.
